The Municipal Election Commission of the Town of James Island, SC hereby gives notice of a Municipal Election set for Tuesday, August 3, 2010.

Persons desiring to vote in the upcoming election must be registered by Saturday, July 3, 2010. To register, contact the Office of Elections and Voter Registration of Charleston County at 744-VOTE (744-8683). Any registered elector who cannot vote in person may be eligible to vote by Absentee Ballot. Voters who are blind, who are otherwise physically handicapped, or who are unable to read or write are entitled to assistance in casting their ballots. Voters wishing more information concerning absentee voting and assisted voting should contact the Office of Elections and Voter Registration of Charleston County.

The following 5 offices shall be included in this Municipal Election: The Mayor and four (4) Town Council Member positions-at-large for the term beginning September, 2010.

Citizens desiring to be candidates for one of the above listed offices must file at the Town of James Island Town Hall at 1238-B Camp Road, James Island, SC 29412. Candidates must be qualified electors residing in the Town at the time of the election. The filing fee for Mayor is \$300.00 and for Town Council is \$150.00. Books will open for filing on Monday, May 24, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 Noon; Tuesday, May 25, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 Noon; Wednesday, May 26, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 Noon; Thursday, May 27, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 Noon; Friday, May 28, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 Noon. The Town Hall will be closed in observance of Memorial Day, on Monday, May 31, 2010. Filing will resume on Tuesday, June 1, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 Noon and the filing period will close on Wednesday, June 2, 2010 at 12:00 Noon. Candidate information packets will be available during the hours indicated at the Town of James Island town Hall at 1238-B Camp Road, James Island, SC 29412.

This is a non-partisan plurality election and no party affiliation shall be placed on the ballot.

The polls shall be open from 7:00 AM until 7:00 PM at the polling places designated below and shall be open during these hours without intermission or adjournment. The Managers of Election shall see that each person offering to vote takes the oath that he/she is qualified to vote at this election according to the Constitution of the State of South Carolina, and that he/she has not voted before in this election.
