**A RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE REVISED
CHARLESTON REGIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN BY THE
COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON**

Resolution No.

WHEREAS the College of Charleston has experienced the effects of natural and man-made hazard events; and

WHEREAS the Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Project Committee has prepared a recommended *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan*; and

WHEREAS the recommended *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan* has been widely circulated for review by residents/business organizations/professional organizations of the unincorporated and incorporated areas of Charleston County, state, federal, regional and local government agencies and has been supported by those reviewers; and

WHEREAS the College of Charleston originally adopted the *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan* in 2006, and is required to adopt the amended version of this plan to remain on a five-year cycle for the College to remain eligible for certain Federal programs in which the College of Charleston participates, and

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that

1. The *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan* is hereby adopted as an official plan of the College of Charleston, and
2. The Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Project Committee is recognized as a continuing entity charged with reviewing, maintaining in accordance with Community Rating System, Flood Mitigation Assistance, and Disaster Mitigation Act requirements, and periodically reporting on the progress towards and revisions to the plan to the College of Charleston.
