- ### *Hurricane Preparation:*
- ❖ Protect building openings from breakage and penetration
 - ❖ Shelter in a safe location away from storm surge and high winds
 - ❖ Have an emergency kit
 - ❖ Secure outdoor objects to reduce flying debris
 - ❖ Trim tree branches overhanging structures
 - ❖ Verify that structures are adequately braced to resist wind uplift
 - ❖ Follow emergency instructions
