<u>Application</u>: The applicant is requesting to amend PD-52A, 3M Company Billboard to PD-52B to allow for the replacement of the existing billboard with a digital electronic billboard.

Zoning History:

In November 1976, County Council approved a request to rezone the subject property from the Agriculture-Residential (AR) Zoning District to the General Commercial (CG) Zoning District.

In November 1993, County Council approved a request to rezone the subject property from the CG Zoning District to Planned Development (PD-52, 3M Company Billboard) Zoning District to allow a billboard on the property, in addition to all uses allowed under the current CG Zoning District. Specific sign standards for the billboard were included in PD-52.

In 2001, the Mount Pleasant Overlay (MP-O) Zoning District was adopted and included a prohibition of billboards and specific standards for signs and sign illumination. In 2007, the MP-O was amended to include the Sweetgrass Basket Special Consideration Area (SBSCA), which encompasses properties south of Highway 17 North from the Isle of Palms Connector to Porchers Bluff Road. The subject property is included in the SBSCA area of the MP-O.

In January 2012, County Council approved amendments to PD-52 to reduce the side setback requirements for the existing billboard from 90 feet to 25 feet to allow the property to be subdivided. Concurrent to the rezoning process in 2012, the subject property was also subdivided into two properties (TMS 558-00-00-927, the subject property, and TMS 558-00-00-146). TMS 558-00-00-146 was annexed into the Town of Mount Pleasant in December 2011, while TMS 558-00-00-927 remained in unincorporated Charleston County and was rezoned to PD-52A.

Parcel Information and Area Description:

PD-52A is currently approved for general commercial uses (now Community Commercial – CC uses) and a billboard use and includes very specific requirements for the location, size, and lighting of the existing billboard. Located along Highway 17 North between Six Mile Road and Long Point Road, the subject property contains a billboard and Richard's Bar. Adjacent properties are located in the Town of Mount Pleasant. To the west, properties are zoned for and contain commercial uses. To the east, properties are zoned in a residential district and contain a church and cemetery.

Overview of PD-52B, 3M Company Billboard:

The applicant is requesting to amend the existing PD-52A to allow for the replacement of the existing billboard with a digital electronic billboard. Specifically, PD-52B requests the following:

- Allow the existing billboard to be removed and replaced with a digital electronic billboard, to be located in the same location as the existing billboard;
- Compliance with ZLDR Section 9.11.5, Billboards, with the exception of the maximum height requirement and the location criteria contained in ZLDR Section 9.11.5.B. The maximum height currently approved in PD-52A is 80 feet, and the applicant is requesting that this requirement remain the same.
- Compliance with the existing, approved setback requirements;
- Clarify the lighting requirements to comply with ZLDR Section 9.11.5.F, Digital or Electronic Billboards; and
- Addition of off-street parking requirements for the billboard use (one space to be used for sign maintenance personnel).

<u>Municipalities Notified/Response</u>: The Town of Mount Pleasant, Town of Awendaw, and Town of McClellanville have been notified of the request. The Town of Mount Pleasant submitted a letter in opposition to the request, which is included in this packet.

<u>Public Input</u>: In addition to the letter of opposition from the Mayor of the Town of Mount Pleasant, staff received 209 emails from citizens in opposition to the request. Fifteen emails in support were also received. These documents are included in this packet.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

According to Section §4.23.9 E (9) of the *Zoning and Land Development Regulations Ordinance (ZLDR)*, applications for PD Development Plans may be approved only if County Council determines that the following criteria are met:

- The PD Development Plan complies with the standards contained in this Article; Staff response: The proposed amendment allows a digital electronic billboard to replace the existing billboard, which is not a digital electronic billboard). It does not modify any of the other planned development uses as approved by County Council in 1993 and amended in 2012. The proposed amendment complies with the standards of this Article.
- The development is consistent with the intent of the *Comprehensive Plan* and other adopted policy documents; and

Staff response: The Comprehensive Plan recommends the continuance of the approved Planned Development uses for the subject property; however, the subject property is also located in the Mount Pleasant Overlay (MP-O) Zoning District, which prohibits billboard uses and recommends Commercial Transition (CT) and Neighborhood Commercial (CN) uses along this portion of Highway 17 North located in the Sweetgrass Basket Special Consideration Area of the MP-O. The currently adopted PD was approved prior to the adoption of the MP-O and the billboard approved as part of the PD is not a digital electronic billboard. The MP-O contains specific standards for signs and sign illumination. When the MP-O was adopted, digital electronic billboards were not prevalent in Charleston County and were not addressed in County zoning regulations or the MP-O; however, the MP-O includes a prohibition on all billboards and includes free-standing sign requirements that specifically address lighting. The high intensity illumination of a digital electronic billboard to a digital electronic format as requested in this application creates an intensity of use that is not consistent with the Mount Pleasant Overlay Zoning District contained in the Charleston County Zoning and Land Development Regulations Ordinance (ZLDR).

• The County and other agencies will be able to provide necessary public services, facilities, and programs to serve the development proposed, at the time the property is developed. *Staff response: The site has been developed and is currently being served by applicable public services, facilities, and programs.*

The requested PD amendment is not be consistent with the Comprehensive Plan and Zoning and Land Development Regulations Ordinance (ZLDR); therefore staff recommends disapproval of the request. However, if Planning Commission decides to recommend approval, or if County Council approves the rezoning request, staff suggests including the following conditions of approval:

- Purpose and Intent: Cross through/delete the word "property"
- Intent and Results, second to last sentence: Change to read "The subject parcel was rezoned in November of 1993 and the PD amended in 2012 to reduce the side yard setback requirements to allow the parcel to be subdivided."
- Lot dimension exhibits on pages 2 and 3: Label as existing or proposed.
- Table of proposed land uses: Change first sentence to read "The PD shall allow Community Commercial Uses including, but not limited to, the existing bar and the replacement of the existing billboard with one digital electronic billboard that is in compliance with the requirements of this PD and the applicable requirements of Section 9.11.5 of the Charleston County Zoning and Land Development Regulations Ordinance with the exception of the location criteria contained in Section 9.11.5.B. In case of conflict, the requirements of this PD shall take precedence over those contained in the ZLDR."
- Location Criteria: Delete "1993 and 2013 amended".
- Setbacks: Delete the first sentence.
- Replace the sentence that begins with "The minimum distance..." with "The minimum distance from a billboard/digital billboard proposed as part of a PD to the nearest on-premises sign may be less restrictive than the standards set forth in the ZLDR, pursuant to ZLDR Art. 4.23."
- Off-Street Parking: Remove "fairgrounds" from the last sentence in this section.
- Buffers and landscaping: Add a statement that development shall comply with the requirements of ZLDR Chapter 9.

Dear Mr. Meyer:

Please accept this letter expressing the Town of Mount Pleasant's concerns and opposition to the above-captioned planned development amendment request.

The Town is most concerned about the precedent this zoning amendment would have. Electronic signs of all types are currently prohibited by the town's sign ordinance. At this time, there are no digital billboards located east of the Cooper. This amendment would increase the pressure to approve additional digital signs in the Town and the unincorporated area. Like the County, the Town has also been approached by outdoor advertising industry representatives with requests to allow digital billboard signs, but to date, Town Council has declined to do so. This position represents the will of our citizenry.

The Town and the County have worked hard over the years to coordinate development standards at our common borders to discourage "development shopping" between jurisdictions. The sign regulations in the Town's Joint Town/County Highway Corridors Overlay District are intended to provide uniform regulations in these areas. While not specific to digital or electronic signs, the overlay regulations specify that flashing or moving signs are prohibited. As you know, the digital signs employ intermittent, changeable copy of varying intensity and duration. When these regulations were written, the digital format did not exist, but the nature of the mutually acceptable signage between jurisdictions should be clear. November 10, 2016 Agenda Item VI. a.3. The subject property is a true "doughnut hole", being completely surrounded by property within the corporate municipal limits of the Town of Mount Pleasant. Its parent parcel, which is under the same ownership, has been annexed into the Town. However, this 0.63 are portion was carved out before that occurred, apparently for the purpose of retaining unincorporated Charleston County zoning authority for the billboard located on it. The Town and the County should act in concert, rather than at-odds with each other, in furtherance of the desires of our residents.

For these reasons we respectfully request that the Commission recommend denial of this zoning amendment request.

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Signage Improvement Planned Development

For Richards Pub in Mount Pleasant, SC

Statement of Objectives:

This Planned Development is being proposed in order to facilitate the provision for the removal of an existing Billboard and replace it with an updated Digital Electronic Billboard on the Richard's Pub property, which has been in existence since 1993. This signage proposal will increase advertising opportunities for the businesses and non-profit agencies located in town of Mount Pleasant and in Charleston County and will provide increased commercial and public service messaging visibility to the travelers along Highway 17-North

Purpose and Intent

The purpose and intent of these Development Guidelines is to incorporate signs into the uses allowed on this property. Such signs will be limited to the restrictions set forth regarding size, height, location, and lighting.

Intent and Results:

In accordance with Section 4.23.4 of the Charleston County Zoning and Development Regulations, this Planned Development is designed to provide a well sited Digital Electronic Billboard that provides information, including public information and safety messages, to travelers along Highway 17. The existing sign is located in the most visible location that can be determined on this property and the new proposed digital billboard will be erected in the same location. The new will use the latest design practices and technology for the construction and long-term use of the sign faces. The replacement of the existing sign with an update state of the art Digital Electronic Billboard in this location along Highway 17-North is an ideal location for this type of use due to the commercial, industrial, and public uses located in the immediate vicinity. The proposed signage, while providing service to residents in the area, is separated far enough from any residential use that the sign will have no negative impact on those dwellings and/or dwellers. This proposal is in compliance and harmony with the character of the surrounding area and Charleston County's Comprehensive Plan which calls for a more intense land use pattern of commercial development in the area of the proposed sign site. The subject parcel was rezoned in November of 1993 and the PD amended in 2012 to make a provision for the constructions and modification of the existing Outdoor Advertising Display. The sign will be in compliance with the Outdoor Advertising of America Association Standards.

Site Information:

The proposed sign will be sited on a 27,288 sf or 0.626 acre parcel that is located along the Richard's Pub's Highway 17- North frontage (TMS#: 558-00-00-927) and is outside any freshwater and/or critical line wetland area with no marsh frontage.

The existing sign may remain as situated on the property. However, if replaced, altered, or relocated in the future, it must meet the following requirements, including Charleston County Zoning Ordinance Criteria regarding off premise signs not inconsistent with these guidelines:

Sign must located along Highway 17-north frontage with setbacks suggested to be the following:

- Minimum front setback: Same as existing setback unless otherwise stipulated.
- Minimum side setback: (existing)
- Maximum height: (existing)
- Lighting: (existing).
- Location Criteria:

The proposed Digital Electronic Billboard will be reconstructed in the original sign's location on Highway 17 N and will utilize the 1993 and 2013 amended setbacks as specified below.

• Setbacks:

Proposed setbacks will comply with original November of 1993 PD and the 2012 amendment. The setbacks are a minimum of sixteen (16) feet from the front and twenty-five (25) feet from the side lot lines.



Setback Exhibit

Cutouts not to exceed 15% of the area size of the face of a sign will be allowed as required by advertisers: however, in no event can these cutouts become permanent enlargements of a sign, or extend the entire length or height of a sign.

• Lighting and/or Electronic Display:

The proposed sign will eliminate the 4 halophone lighting each side as specified in the original PD. This lighting will be replaced with an LED message board that will comply with the standards of Article 9.11.5 (F). This digital display will eliminate the need for cutouts and extensions outside the dimensions of the digital display's face.

In no event can signs be located within 500 feet of each other. Additionally, it is the intent of these guidelines to allow the possibility of relocating the sign within 500 feet of the existing sign location along the same frontage. The 500 feet measurement may be taken from a point directly across the right-of-way perpendicular to the existing sign.

The minimum distance to the nearest on-premises sign for billboards, including digital billboards, may not be less restrictive than the standards set forth in the ZLDR pursuant to Art. 4.23.

All other Charleston County Zoning Ordinance requirements not addressed in this Planned Development will be adhered to regarding off- premise signs, but it is expressly understood that these guidelines take precedence over ant general language in the zoning ordinance.

• Off-Street Parking:

The siting of a Digital Electronic Billboard on this property will comply with Article 9.3, Off Street Parking and Loading of the Charleston County Zoning and Land Development Regulations. Since this article contains no requirement for an off-street parking space for signage, the property owner will provide one compliant space, to be used for sign maintenance personnel, within the adjacent fairgrounds parking area.

• Tree Protection and Preservation:

The siting of a Digital Electronic Billboard on this property will comply with Article 9.4, Tree Protection and Preservation of the Charleston County Zoning and Land Development Regulations.

• Buffers and Landscaping:

The sign base area will be landscaped and shielded from Highway 17-North and adjacent land uses utilizing the existing buffer vegetation and landscaping on site.

Development Schedule:

The property owner will apply for all permits and construct the proposed sign within 24 months of the PD approval by the Charleston County Council.

Zoning and Land Development Regulation Compliance:

- The property owner affirms its commitment to comply with and include any processes and requirements not addressed in the Planned Development will comply with the Zoning and Land Development Regulations for the CG Zoning District.
- The property owner agrees to proceed with the proposed development in accordance with the Charleston County Zoning and Land Development Regulations, the Charleston County Comprehensive Plan and to any conditions which may be attached to this rezoning.
- The property owner affirms its understanding that the provisions of Article 3.10, Development Standards and Tree Variances of the Charleston County Zoning and Land Development Regulations do not apply and that all major changes to the planned development must be approved by the Charleston County Council.
- The property owner believes this proposal complies with the approval criteria of Section 4.23.9(E)(9) Charleston County Zoning and Land Development Regulations in the following ways:
 - This proposal is in compliance with the standards contained in this article by providing signage that is located in the most visible location, uses the latest design practices and technology for the construction and long-term use of the sign faces, and is situated in a commercial, industrial, and public use area.
 - This proposal is in compliance and harmony with the character of the surrounding area and Charleston County's Comprehensive Plan, which calls for a more intense land use pattern of commercial development.
 - The siting of a Digital Electronic Billboard on this property will have little to no impact on the schools, utilities, the street network, or public grounds.

Historic and Archaeological Survey:

There are no historic or archaeological sites affected by this proposal. Figure 1 shows the nearest potential site to this location:

Dear Mr. Meyer:

Please accept this letter expressing the Town of Mount Pleasant's concerns and opposition to the above-captioned planned development amendment request.

The Town is most concerned about the precedent this zoning amendment would have. Electronic signs of all types are currently prohibited by the town's sign ordinance. At this time, there are no digital billboards located east of the Cooper. This amendment would increase the pressure to approve additional digital signs in the Town and the unincorporated area. Like the County, the Town has also been approached by outdoor advertising industry representatives with requests to allow digital billboard signs, but to date, Town Council has declined to do so. This position represents the will of our citizenry.

The Town and the County have worked hard over the years to coordinate development standards at our common borders to discourage "development shopping" between jurisdictions. The sign regulations in the Town's Joint Town/County Highway Corridors Overlay District are intended to provide uniform regulations in these areas. While not specific to digital or electronic signs, the overlay regulations specify that flashing or moving signs are prohibited. As you know, the digital signs employ intermittent, changeable copy of varying intensity and duration. When these regulations were written, the digital format did not exist, but the nature of the mutually acceptable signage between jurisdictions should be clear.

The subject property is a true "doughnut hole", being completely surrounded by property within the corporate municipal limits of the Town of Mount Pleasant. Its parent parcel, which is under the same ownership, has been annexed into the Town. However, this 0.63 acre portion was carved out before that occurred, apparently for the purpose of retaining unincorporated Charleston County zoning authority for the billboard located on it. The Town and the County should act in concert, rather than at-odds with each other, in furtherance of the desires of our residents.

For these reasons we respectfully request that the Commission recommend denial of this zoning amendment request.
