About the Earth Day Festival

The Charleston County Earth Day Festival 2015 will take place on Saturday, April 18, 2015. The purpose of the Earth Day Festival is to increase awareness about the Lowcountry's environmental programs, while celebrating our diverse community and providing hands-on, fun activities for the whole family.

About the Art Contest

The Earth Day Art Contest is designed to highlight the creative talents of Charleston County students, grades K–12, and to promote celebrating Earth Day in Charleston. The selected artwork will be used as the design of the official festival t-shirt, which will be sold at the event. **The theme for this year's Earth Day Festival is "Protect the Planet, Conserve Resources"**. Please use this theme as a focus for the creative art design.

Criteria for Contest

- Students submitting artwork for this contest must be residents of Charleston County.
- Students participating in the Earth Day Art Contest must be in **grade levels K - 12**.
- The artwork must be the original work of the student only.
- Students may submit only one art entry for the Earth Day Art Contest.
- The image created should convey the theme of the Earth Day Festival (**Protect Our Planet, Conserve Resources**)
- **2-D images SHOULD NOT BE LARGER than 8 1/2" x 11" in size. Any entries received that are larger than 8 1/2" x 11" will not be considered for the contest.**
- Artwork may be in color or black and white.
- Prizes will be awarded!
