Are You Recycling Right? 10 Things You Should Know

Q: What items are accepted in my recycling cart?

A: Aluminum and steel cans, plastic bottles and containers, glass bottles and jars, and paper products like magazines, paper board, office paper, mail, notepads and cardboard boxes.

Q: What items should I keep out of my recycling cart?

A: Keep soft/film plastics like plastic shopping bags, bubble wrap, saran wrap and zip-loc bags, shredded paper and styrofoam packaging and containers out of your recycling cart.

Q: I have an old TV; can I place it into my cart to be recycled?

A: No. You may drop off certain electronics (televisions, printers, monitors and computers) at a Charleston County Convenience Center, but do not place these items in your recycling cart.

Q: Can I bag my recyclables before placing them into my recycling cart?

A: No, recyclable items must be placed loose in your cart, not in bags or boxes.

Q: How should I place my cart on the curb for pickup?

A: Face the handles of your cart toward your house and make sure the cart is at least 3 feet away from any obstacle (parked car, mailbox, bush) to allow the recycling truck to service your cart.

Q: When should I put my cart on the curb for pickup?

A: Residential recycling carts are serviced once every two weeks; for your specific service day, refer to the enclosed map and calendar. In order to receive

service, your cart must be placed correctly out on the curb NO LATER THAN 7am on your service day.



A: All boxes must be broken down flat before being placed in the recycling cart. Excess boxes that cannot fit in the recycling cart must be broken down and cut down to no larger than 3' x 3' and stacked neatly beside your recycling cart for pickup.



A: Charleston County provides recycling collection ONLY; garbage is collected by the municipality in which you live, or by a third party company in unincorporated areas. For information on how to obtain a trash can or other trash service questions, contact your municipality.

Your recycling cart should be placed at the curb before 7 am on your scheduled pickup day.


Recycling service occurs every other week.
