

Rule to Show Cause to Satisfy Mortgage

It appearing from the Motion of the Plaintiff that a mortgage is of record that has been paid in full and unjustly encumbrances the real property of the Plaintiff and that either the Defendant unjustly refuses to satisfy same or cannot be found to satisfy same; and

It further appearing that pursuant to S.C. Code section 29-3-360 Plaintiff is entitled to a Rule to Show Cause why satisfaction of said mortgage should not be entered against said mortgage on the public records,

Now, therefore,

It is Ordered that this matter be referred to the Honorable Roger M. Young, Master in Equity for Charleston County for further proceeds consistent with this Order and that the Defendant appear before the said Master in Equity on the ____ day of _____, 1996 at ____ _m. in compliance with the Motion and this Order, at the Office of the Master in Equity for Charleston County, Charleston County Courthouse, 2144 Melbourne Avenue, Room 232, North Charleston, South Carolina 29405, to show cause why, if any he can, satisfaction of the mortgage of _____ in favor of _____ dated _____ in the original principal amount of \$_____ and recorded in the Office of the RMC for Charleston County in Book ____ at Page _____, should not be entered thereon.

It is further Ordered that copies of this Order and the attached Motion be personally served as promptly as possible on the aforesaid Defendant.
