Phase One is Done! Time to Take a Look at Holly Grove

Join Charleston County for a ribbon cutting May 6 at 11 a.m. in Hollywood

<u>Charleston County Government</u> receives grant funding annually from the <u>U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development</u> (HUD) to facilitate resources that develop viable communities. The Holly Grove Subdivision is one of the communities designed to help families in need. The <u>Town of Hollywood</u> will announce the completion of Phase One of the Holly Grove Subdivision located on 5171 Baptist Hill Road in Hollywood with a ribbon cutting and dedication on Monday, May 6, at 11 a.m.

Hollywood Grove Subdivision is a rental housing development for low to moderate income families. The Town partnered with Charleston County Government through the Charleston Urban Entitlement Grant, Lowcountry Housing Trust, and PASTOR'S Inc. to make the vision a reality.

"The close-out of phase one in the Holly Grove Subdivision is a major step toward the provision of sustainable housing for residents," said Mayor Heyward. "The opportunity for low to moderate income families to afford a high quality home has come to fruition in Hollywood."

Phase two of the project will begin immediately and at this time it includes two more units.
