Poll Managers Needed in Mt. Pleasant for Nov. 5 Election

Earn \$120 and provide a valuable service to your community at the same time!

The [Charleston County Board of Elections and Voter Registration \(BEVR\)](#) is in need of additional [poll managers](#) for Mount Pleasant's upcoming election on Tuesday, Nov. 5, 2013. Several other jurisdictions have elections on the same day but the poll manager positions have been filled.

"Poll managers have a unique opportunity to serve the community, meet their neighbors and become involved in the democratic process," said Joseph Debney, BEVR's Executive Director.

Poll managers are compensated \$120 (\$60 for training and \$60 for working on Election Day) for each election they work. The poll manager must work Election Day to be paid for the training session.

Election Day duties include: processing of voters, ballot distribution, activation of the voting system machines, compliance with election law and procedures, and general voter assistance.

Applicants must be:

- A registered voter in Charleston County or an adjoining county (Dorchester, Berkeley, Georgetown or Colleton County). Students ages 16 and 17 may apply as well although they are not registered voters.
- Willing and able to attend a Poll Manager Training Session (two to three hours in length) and pass a written certification test.
- Prepared to work the entire Election Day, from 6 a.m. until approximately 7:30 p.m.
- Non-partisan and neutral when working an election.
