Charleston County Council Announces Vacancies on Boards and Commissions Applications accepted through Monday, February 24

Charleston County Council announces the following vacancies on boards and commissions:

- Construction Board of Adjustment and Appeals
 - o 1 vacancy for a civil engineer

 - o 1 vacancy for an architect
 - o 1 vacancy for a resident state fire marshal
- Accommodation Tax Advisory Committee
 - 3 vacancies, applicants must reside in unincorporated Charleston County and preference will be given to those residing in unincorporated West Ashley and Johns Island
- Firemen's Insurance and Inspection Fund

 - o 4 vacancies for Awendaw Consolidated Fire District
