Charleston County Steps up to Help Disabled Veterans Return to the Workforce County's Veterans Affairs Office offers Non-Paid Work Experience Program

At last count there are three million veterans in the U.S. with a service related disability, according to a 2012 study by the <u>U.S. Department of Labor's Bureau of Statistics</u>. That same study revealed 6.5% of those same veterans were unemployed. The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs hopes to change that through its new <u>Non-Paid Work Experience Program (NPWE)</u>, and Charleston County is helping.

"Charleston County is providing local veterans with the chance to get back to normal and back into the workforce," said <u>Charleston County Veterans Affairs</u> Director Donald Morillo. "We've worked very closely with the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs to get this program up and running and it's been a success so far."

Charleston County's <u>Veterans Affairs Office</u> and <u>Human Resources Department</u> have worked with the national organization to set up a local NPWE. The program's three goals are training for disabled vets, real world work experience and job placement.

So far, 11 veterans have been placed in various County departments. The first was hired in November 2013 and another veteran has already been hired to a full-time position. "This program has been a win-win situation for all parties involved," said Director of Human Resources Fagan Stackhouse. "Veterans get hands-on job training and a chance to learn about public service and the County receives talented and experienced individuals to help our citizens on a daily basis."
