Charleston County to Host Public Meeting for Airport Connector Road Project

Presentation and Q&A session to be held at Jerry Zucker Middle School on June 18

[Charleston County Government](#) will host a public information meeting to discuss the [Airport Connector Road Project](#). The meeting is scheduled for 6-8 p.m. Wednesday, June 18, at Jerry Zucker Middle School located at 6401 Dorchester Road in North Charleston. The meeting will be conducted in an open-house format, with a project overview presentation at 6:30 p.m., followed by a 20-minute Q&A session.

The goal of the Airport Connector Road Project will be to provide increased connectivity for local commuters as well as residents and visitors traveling directly to and from the Charleston International Airport.

“Meetings with key stakeholders and the community will be crucial throughout the ongoing planning, design and permitting phases of the project,” said Richard Turner with Charleston County’s Transportation Development Department, who oversees the project.

The project has been moving forward in recent months, and Charleston County representatives will present alternatives that are being studied and share findings on potential impacts for the community and residents. Attendees will also have the opportunity to review exhibits, provide written comments, and meet one-on-one with County and study team representatives.

Throughout the planning process, there will be regular opportunities for community feedback via public meetings and the Airport Connector Road Project website at <http://acr.charlestoncounty.org>. Timelines with project status, significant milestones and future public meetings will also be available on the site.
