Tropical Storm Isaias Update #4

Based on the latest track of Tropical Storm Isaias, <u>Charleston County Government</u> offices will close at 1 p.m. on Monday, August 3. This includes the downtown Judicial Center Complex and Convenience Centers. Curbside recycling operations will be delayed by one day this week. Charleston County will resume normal operations on Tuesday, August 4.

The Board of Zoning and Appeals meeting scheduled at 5 p.m. Monday, August 3 at the Public Services Building is canceled and will be rescheduled on August 31.
