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Traffic Alert: Nighttime Lane Shifts for Main Road Segment A Project

Lane shifts will begin tonight, September 16 at 9 p.m. on Main Road, Old Charleston Road, and US 17 (please see attached map). There are no scheduled lane closures. If traffic does become congested, trucks will pull over to allow drivers through.

Details:

- Work is scheduled for September 16 through September 19 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- There will be large electronic signs with arrows on the back of trucks directing traffic.
- Work vehicles will pullover and allow for vehicles to pass to relieve potential traffic backups.
- Residents are asked to use caution while driving through the construction area.

Charleston County Public Works is testing the structure of the pavement as part of the design process for the Main Road Corridor Segment A project. Segment A includes improvements along the US 17 and Main Road corridor extending from the intersection of Main Road and Bees Ferry to the intersection of Main Road and River/Chisolm Road. The primary purpose of the project is to reduce congestion and improve capacity along this corridor. It also includes mobility improvements for bicyclist and pedestrian traffic.
