Charleston County Continues Hands-On Approach to Combat Recycling Contamination

Environmental Management staff will be flipping cart lids at the curb to ensure citizens are "Recycling Right"

Charleston County Environmental Management is continuing efforts to combat non-recyclable material found in the County's recycling program. Beginning October 11, 2021, staff will be checking curbside recycling carts for contaminated material. Carts with non-compliant contents will receive an "Oops" tag with educational information.

Non-recyclables frequently found in recycling carts include plastic bags and plastic wrap, food waste, wood, concrete, Styrofoam, clothing, blankets, tanglers (e.g., cables, cords, hoses, belts, etc.), large plastic items and household garbage. Non-recyclable contamination damages equipment, poses worker safety issues, and increases the cost of recycling.

The County recycling program only accepts glass bottles/jars, aluminum/steel cans, plastic bottles/containers, cartons, paperboard/cardboard, and paper. Do not leave material outside of your cart. Flatten all cardboard boxes and cut them to size, if necessary. Residents can drop off overflow recyclable material at any Charleston County <u>drop site locations</u>.
