Nighttime Lane Closures in Downtown Charleston

This week Charleston County Public Works will close lanes on Calhoun, George, and Queen Streets to spray asphalt rejuvenator. **Parking will be prohibited during work hours.** Vehicles parked after 7 p.m. will be towed. Flaggers will be on-site to direct traffic. All dates and times are weather dependent.

Tentative construction dates:

- Calhoun Street: Tuesday, November 9 and Wednesday, November 10 from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- **George Street:** Wednesday, November 10 from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Queen Street: Saturday, November 13 from 12 a.m. to 8 a.m.

The spray-on rejuvenator treatment protects the asphalt from sun and water exposure. It also extends the road's life by five years, which reduces long-term maintenance costs.
