

RESOLUTION 2008-11

A RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE REVISED *CHARLESTON REGIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN*.

Whereas, the North Charleston District and the County of Charleston has experienced the effects of natural and man-made hazard events; and,

Whereas, the Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Project Committee has prepared a recommended *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan*; and,


Whereas, the recommended *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan* has been widely circulated for review by residents/business organizations/professional organizations of the unincorporated and incorporated areas of Charleston County, state, federal, regional and local government agencies and has been supported by those reviewers; and,

Whereas, the North Charleston District originally adopted the *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan* in 1999 and readopted it in 2004, and is required to adopt the amended version of this plan on a five-year cycle for the North Charleston District to remain eligible for certain Federal programs in which Charleston County participates, and

Now, therefore, be it resolved that:

1. The *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan* is hereby adopted as an official plan of the North Charleston District, and
2. The Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Project Committee is recognized as a continuing entity charged with reviewing, maintaining in accordance with Community Rating System, Flood Mitigation Assistance, and Disaster Mitigation Act requirements, and the North Charleston District will participate on their Committee.
