A RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE REVISED CHARLESTON REGIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN BY THE TOWN OF SULLIVAN'S ISLAND

WHEREAS the Town of Sullivan's Island has experienced the effects of natural and man-made hazard events; and

WHEREAS the Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Project Committee has prepared a recommended *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan*; and

WHEREAS the recommended *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan* has been widely circulated for review by residents/business organizations/professional organizations of the unincorporated and incorporated areas of Charleston County, state, federal, regional and local government agencies and has been supported by those reviewers; and

WHEREAS the Town of Sullivan's Island originally adopted the *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan* in 1999 and readopted it in 2004, and is required to adopt the amended version of this plan on a five-year cycle for the Town to remain eligible for certain Federal programs in which Charleston County and the Town of Sullivan's Island participates, and


NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that

1. The *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan* is hereby adopted as an official hazard mitigation plan of the Town of Sullivan's Island, and
2. The Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Project Committee is recognized as a continuing entity charged with reviewing, maintaining in accordance with Community Rating System, Flood Mitigation Assistance, and Disaster Mitigation Act requirements, and periodically reporting on the progress towards and revisions to the plan to the Charleston County Council and the Town of Sullivan's Island Council.
