
- WHEREAS** the City of Charleston has experienced the effects of natural and manmade hazard events; and
- WHEREAS** the Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Project Committee has prepared a recommended *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan*; and
- WHEREAS** the recommended *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan* has been widely circulated for review by residents/business organizations/professional organizations of the unincorporated and incorporated areas of Charleston County, state, federal, regional and local government agencies and has been supported by those reviewers; and
- WHEREAS** the City of Charleston originally adopted the *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan* in 1999 and readopted it in 2004, and is required to adopt the amended version of this plan on a five-year cycle for the City of Charleston to remain eligible for certain Federal programs in which City of Charleston participates, and

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that

1. The *Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan* is hereby adopted as an official plan of the City of Charleston, and
2. The Charleston Regional Hazard Mitigation Project Committee is recognized as a continuing entity charged


with reviewing, maintaining in accordance with
