

**NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION  
CITY OF ISLE OF PALMS, SC  
CORRECTION  
NOVEMBER 5, 2019**

**Notice is hereby given that** the Charleston County Board of Elections and Voter Registration will conduct a General Election for the City of Isle of Palms on Tuesday, November 5, 2019 to fill (4) four City Council seats. This is a nonpartisan, municipal election, and no party affiliation shall be placed on the ballot. **Term of office will expire December 2023.**

**The City of Isle of Palms will have (2) two seat to fill for Water and Sewer Commission. Signed petitions are required for these seats only and must contain the names of at least 5% of the active registered voters in the City of Isle of Palms (5% of 4172 =209).**

Candidate filing opens 12:00 noon on Monday, August 5, 2019 and filing closes 12:00 noon on Monday, August 19, 2019. Filing fees for the Office of Town Council is \$100.00. **There are no filing fees for the seat of Water and Sewer Commission.**

Any person declaring candidacy under this section who cannot afford the required filing fee and so declares himself or herself to be an indigent, shall file a written appeal for relief with the Charleston County Board of Elections and Voter Registration not later than (60) sixty days prior to the election.

A Statement of Economic Interest form must be filed electronically (on-line) at <http://ethics.sc.gov> prior to filing a Statement of Candidacy and or Petition. Those requiring electronic filing assistance may contact the South Carolina State Ethics Commission at 803-253-4192.

Residents desiring to file as a candidate for the City Council must file a Statement of Candidacy with the City of Isle of Palms, 1207 Palm Blvd, Isle of Palms, SC 29451. **Please make checks payable to the City of Isle of Palms.** Business hours are Monday – Friday, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. You may obtain additional information by calling the office at 843-886-6428 or by visiting the City’s website at [www.iop.net](http://www.iop.net).

The last day that persons may register to be eligible to vote in this election is **October 5, 2019**. If submitting a registration application by mail or fax, it must be post marked no later than **October 5, 2019**.

Registered voters who cannot vote in person may be eligible to vote by absentee ballot. Absentee ballots may be obtained from the Charleston County Board of Elections and Voter Registration. You may call 744-8683 or send an email to [absentee@charlestoncounty.org](mailto:absentee@charlestoncounty.org) to inquire about the availability of absentee ballots.

At 9:00 a.m., on Election Day, the Charleston County Board of Elections and Voter Registration will begin the examination of the absentee ballot return envelopes. This process will take place at the elections office, 4367 Headquarters Road, North Charleston, SC.

On Thursday, November 7, 2019 at **9:10 a.m.**, the Charleston County Board of Canvassers will hold a public hearing at the elections office, 4367 Headquarters Road, North Charleston, SC, to determine the validity of all ballots challenged in this election, and certify election results.

Any Runoff Election will be held on Tuesday, November 19, 2019 at the precincts listed below.

This Municipal Election will be held under new rules for providing Photo ID at the polling place. The polls will open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. at the polling places fixed by law in this county:
