- Strategies
 - Competitive Pay
 - Increase minimum wage to \$15/hour
 - Contain cost increases
 - Increase budgeted personnel savings to account for current vacancy levels
 - No new FTEs/reprogram
 vacant FTEs to address most
 critical FTE needs

GENERAL FUND REVENUES UP \$21.0M TO \$292.7M

- Net property tax revenues down \$15m
 - Increased by growth in property base
 - Reduced by higher credit from the Local Option Sales Tax
 - Including some from prior years
 - 28% reduction for homeowners
- Sales Tax up \$21m
 - 100% of budgeted amount returned as credit
- Interest Earnings up \$1m

GENERAL FUND DISBURSEMENT UP \$21.0M TO \$292.7M

- Personnel up \$3.3m
 - Employee compensation & benefits
 - Annualization of FY 2022 pay changes
 - Minimum wage increase to \$15/hour
 - Increases offset by higher budgeted savings based on existing vacancy levels
- Operating up \$11.0m
 - Inflation
 - Fuel prices
 - Contract costs
 - Opening new facilities
 - Libraries
 - Juvenile Detention
 - Social Services Building

GENERAL FUND DISBURSEMENT UP \$21.0M TO \$292.7M

- Capital Up \$0.3m
 - Technology projects funding higher
- Transfers Out up
 - Facilities maintenance projects
 - Fleet replacement
