Hurricane Preparation:

- Protect building openings from breakage and penetration
- Shelter in a safe location away from storm surge and high winds
- ❖ Have an emergency kit
- ❖ Secure outdoor objects to reduce flying debris
- ❖ Trim tree branches overhanging structures
- Verify that structures are adequately braced to resist wind uplift
- Follow emergency instructions
