Charleston Center offers a wide variety of services to meet community needs (see reverse for levels of care):

- Withdrawal Management Services (Detox)
- Residential treatment services for adult men, women, pregnant or parenting women and their children
- Outpatient care for adolescents and adults
- ADSAP (Alcohol and Drug Safety Action Plan)
- Evidence-based treatment
- Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)
- Urine Drug Screenings
- HIV/HCV Screenings

Services Provided

<u>Withdrawal Management (Detox):</u> Medically monitored treatment for adults in acute withdrawal that require medical intervention.

<u>Transitional Care Unit:</u> Residential treatment services for adults requiring continuous therapeutic care in recovery from substance use disorders.

New Life Unit: Residential treatment for pregnant and parenting women with a substance use disorder. Women can bring two children (newborn to age 5).

<u>Outpatient Services:</u> Individual and group counseling, as well as Intensive Outpatient Services (IOP), are available for flexible scheduling. Programs are available for adolescents, men, and women; group sessions can be male only, female only, or co-ed.

Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT): Medication treatment of opioid and alcohol use disorders are offered at Charleston Center in combination with clinical counseling.

<u>Prevention/Education Services:</u> Offered to schools and other community organizations to provide alcohol and drug education, risk reduction activities, and retailer education. Speakers for community and school events are available at no charge.

Alcohol and Drug Safety Action Program (ADSAP): Education and treatment services for persons with a DUAC/ DUI/BUI conviction, or who have had their driver's license suspended.

<u>Therapeutic Child Treatment Services:</u> Designed to address the needs of children with developmental delays due to parental substance use disorders.

<u>Criminal Justice Services:</u> Drug Court and Detention Center services available for justice involved individuals.

We are a *Trauma-Informed Care* organization, and accredited by *CARF* (Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities).
