Overview

Charleston Center's New Life Unit provides intensive, long-term residential substance use treatment.

Women in treatment may have up to two of their children (newborn through five years old) reside with them.

New Life Unit is for women who...

- * *Are 18 years of age*
- * *Have a severe substance use disorder*
- * *Are pregnant or parenting*
- * *Priority admission is given to pregnant, intravenous drug users*

Financial

Most insurance and Medicaid are accepted and billed on your behalf. Individual arrangements for payment plans can be made at initial intake, or as financial conditions change.

Our Treatment Curriculum

24-hour medical monitoring is provided to all women and children.

Psychiatric and mental health concerns are addressed simultaneously with substance use disorders.

Supportive family members are encouraged to attend family group and visitation weekly.

Evidence-based approaches are delivered in individual and group counseling.

The following topics are addressed:

- * *Family*
- * *Relationships*
- * *Parenting*
- * *Drug and Alcohol Education*
- * *Spirituality*
- * *Self-Esteem*
- * *Recovery Maintenance*
- * *Managing Feelings*
- * *Nutrition*
- * *Anger Management*
- * *Community Support Groups*

Developing healthy, supportive, trusting relationships with other women in recovery is a lifelong benefit of a gender-specific program such as the one offered at Charleston Center's New Life Unit.

Child Development Program

Children of women in the New Life program receive screenings, an assessment and a treatment plan tailored to their developmental needs.

Our licensed childcare program is staffed by credentialed childcare specialists.
