### Improvements Amendments

In 1988, Congress passed the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA), establishing quality standards for all laboratory testing to ensure the accuracy, reliability and timeliness of patient test results regardless of where the test is performed. In total, CLIA covers approximately 200,000 laboratory entities.

The Charleston Center UDS Lab is CLIA licensed and American Proficiency Testing certified. We have a laboratory director and two certified lab technicians.

## Types of Testing

We offer a wide selection of tests including THC, Cocaine, Benzodiazepine, Amphetamine, Methadone Barbiturate, and Opiates, along with adulterates (PH, and specific gravity).
