ORIGINATING OFFICE PLEASE NOTE:

The 2021 PGA Championship is scheduled to begin on May 20, 2021 at the Kiawah Island Golf Resort Ocean Course. This event draws visitors from throughout the world and generates millions of dollars for the local economy. However this creates a major traffic event that is further complicated by the location and single access road to Kiawah Island. During the 2012 PGA Championship, the event and community experienced significant traffic issues and delays due to the inefficient movement of traffic in and out of the parking lot. The congestion and delays were felt within the Johns Island community along Betsy Kerrison Parkway, Bohicket Road and River Road.

The County received a request to assist with the planning, construction and funding of intersection improvements along Kiawah Island Parkway to help alleviate and/or prevent some of the significant traffic issues and delays we experienced during the 2012 PGA Championship. The Town of Kiawah Island is planning to resurface Kiawah Island Parkway in the spring of 2020 and it would more cost effective and less disruptive to the community to complete the projects at the same time.

The estimated cost of the intersection improvements is \$475,000. The funds would be provided to the Town of Kiawah Island for design, permitting and construction of the intersection improvements. This would also serve as a match to the investment being made by the Town of Kiawah Island on Kiawah Island Parkway.

Funds for this project are available due to the completion of four projects and the reallocation of available project funds. Staff intends to request that the \$177,112.82 for the Calhoun St at James Island Connector Intersection be reconciled as part of the FY 2021 budget.
