Charleston County Local Accommodation Tax Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Does Airbnb remit local accommodation taxes for Charleston County and its' local municipalities?

A. Airbnb currently does not collect and remit local accommodation taxes to Charleston County. Airbnb currently only collects taxes collected and remitted to South Carolina Department of Revenue. This does not include local county and municipal accommodation taxes in Charleston County. **Short-term rental owners are responsible for collecting and remitting local accommodation taxes to Charleston County for these rentals.**

Q. Do I need to report anything for my rentals on HomeAway.com or VRBO?

A. When renting through VRBO or HomeAway, you are still required to have a Charleston County accommodation account. VRBO or HomeAway does not provide us with a list of properties so to better assist you as we work with VRBO and HomeAway we are asking that you submit the following: (If information is not received your account will become delinquent)

- Your completed coupon.
- A copy of your monthly statement from VRBO or HomeAway (showing gross rental revenue and taxes collected by VRBO or HomeAway).
- Please fill out your coupon per usual and submit without payment for these rentals.

Q. How can I remit my accommodation payments and how often?

A. Currently payments may be remitted via mail or in person to Charleston County Revenue Collections Department, 4045 Bridge View Dr., North Charleston, SC 29405. Reporting and paying of Accommodations Fees are completed on a monthly basis regardless of annual gross receipts amounts. This is effective January 2024.
