### **Lost Exotic Pet**

(James Island, SC) On February 22, 2015, an owner was walking her 10 months old African Serval pet on a walking trail near Bassett Court on James Island when it got frightened by a dog. The Serval slipped out of its harness and ran into the woods. The African Serval is described as a 10 months old, 35lbs, with yellowish orange type fur with black spots similar to that of a Cheeta. The Serval is de-clawed and nocturnal. According to the owner, the Serval is not aggressive and has a microchip implanted in it. The Serval was last seen on James Island on February 22, 2015.
