One person injured in Woodside Manor shooting

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – A shooting that left one person injured Friday afternoon in the Ladson area remains under investigation by the Charleston County Sheriff's Office.

Deputies responded shortly before 3:40 p.m. to 4420 Garwood Drive in the Woodside Manor community. They found a male victim suffering a gunshot wound to an arm. The victim was transported to Trident Medical Center for treatment of the injury that was not life-threatening. The deputies searched the area but did not find any suspects.

Investigators determined that the victim had been shot outside before taking cover inside a home. They found evidence of multiple gunshots being fired.

No detailed suspect description was immediately available, and no arrests have been made.

UPDATE Wednesday, May 11, 2023

Deputies have arrested a 16-year-old boy on two counts of attempted murder in the March 10 shooting in Woodside.

The victims, both 17-year-old boys, told deputies that they had been working on a vehicle when someone started shooting at them. A bullet struck one of the 17-year-olds in an arm.

Detectives canvassed the area and interviewed witnesses. Information developed during the investigation led to the identification of the 16-year-old suspect, who was located Monday at a convenience store on Highway 78 in Ladson. As they approached him, deputies saw the

juvenile discard a firearm onto a shelf. The juvenile was arrested on the attempted murder warrants, as well as charges of unlawfully carrying a handgun and possession of a handgun by a person under 18.
