CCSO solicits tips in 2024 fatal Ladson shooting

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Detectives with the Charleston County Sheriff's Office are asking for the public's help in finding the suspect(s) responsible for the death of 20-year-old Keonna Brown.

In the early morning hours of Sunday, May 26, 2024, Brown was attending a high school graduation party in the 9700 block of Tremont Avenue in Ladson when gunfire erupted. Brown was struck and killed.

Charleston County Detectives are actively working to solve this case. Detectives are aware that there were



more than 100 people at the party at the time of the incident. However, less than a dozen people have come forward to work with investigators. Detectives are asking witnesses to come forward and share any information they may have about the events leading to the shooting.

No arrests have been made at this time. The Charleston County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigations Division and Forensic Services Unit will continue to investigate.
