CCSO Traffic Unit investigators seek the public's help in fatal hit-and-run

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Charleston County Sheriff's Office (CCSO) deputies are investigating a fatal hit-and-run that occurred late Saturday night between a vehicle and a pedestrian in Hollywood.

On Saturday, July 12, 2025, Charleston County deputies received reports that a man was in the roadway near the 5300 block of Cherry Hill Road. The pedestrian was pronounced dead at the scene, and the Charleston County Coroner's Office responded accordingly.

While there were no witnesses, CCSO Traffic Unit investigators have identified the vehicle make and model based on debris left at the scene. Investigators are asking the public to be on the lookout for a 2017 or 2018 Infinity Q50 that is dark in color and would have front-end damage consistent with a hit-and-run.
