Sheriff J. Al Cannon, Jr. selected to National Domestic Communication Executive Advisory Board

(Charleston County, SC) In September 2016, Charleston County Sheriff Al Cannon was nominated by the Major County Sheriff's Association to replace Sheriff Rich Stanek, Hennepin County Sheriff's Office in Minneapolis on the National Domestic Communications Assistance Center Executive Advisory Board (EAB). The nomination process began under former United States Attorney General Loretta Lynch's Administration, and was finally approved by the current United States Attorney General Jeff Sessions on February 21, 2017.

The National Domestic Communications Assistance Center (NDCAC) is a National center, organized under the Department of Justice (DOJ), designed as a hub for technical knowledge management that will facilitate the sharing of solutions and know-how among law enforcement agencies, and strengthen law enforcement's relationships with the communications industry. The NDCAC will leverage/share collective technical knowledge and resources of law enforcement on issues involving real-time and stored communications to address challenges posed by advanced communications services and technologies.

The NDCAC, located in Fredericksburg, Virginia, opened in early 2013. The NDCAC facility is staffed with technical experts dedicated to supporting the law enforcement community. It also accommodates technical training sessions and meetings between law enforcement and industry.
