## Construction Complete on Sidewalks in North Charleston and West Ashley

*Crews complete sidewalks funded by the Transportation Sales Tax*

[Charleston County Government](#) announces the completion of new sidewalks on Antler Drive in North Charleston and Dickens Street in West Ashley. Both projects were funded by the [Charleston County Transportation Sales Tax Program](#) and approved by [Charleston County Council](#) as a part of its 2009 Transportation Sales Tax [annual allocation for local paving projects](#).

### **Antler Drive Sidewalk (North Charleston):**

- The Antler Drive Sidewalk Project included the construction of a new sidewalk beginning at Greenridge Road and continuing to the existing sidewalk near the intersection of Otranto Drive.

### **Dickens Street Sidewalk (West Ashley):**

- The Dickens Street Sidewalk Project included the construction of a new sidewalk along the southwest side of Dickens Street.
- The new sidewalk begins at Orange Grove Road and ends at the intersection of Sam Rittenberg Boulevard (S.C. 7).
- Minor drainage improvements were also made along Dickens Street to allow for the construction of the sidewalk.
- At the intersection of Dickens Street and Sam Rittenberg Boulevard, the existing traffic signals were updated to include signalized pedestrian crossing.
