3. **5-8 p.m. on Friday, May 4:** Lonnie Hamilton III Public Services Building (4045 Bridge View Drive; North Charleston)

During a regular meeting in February, [Charleston County Council](#) approved funding for a second year of the Summer Youth Work Program. This year, the program is being expanded to a seven-week program that will run from Monday, June 4 to Thursday, July 19. The program will include a two-day orientation where Workplace Readiness Skills will be presented by Charleston County Government and SC State Library training staff.

**Student eligibility requirements for the Summer Youth Work Program are:**

- Age 16-21
- Currently attending high school or college
- Residents of Charleston County
