"These seminars are required by federal law, but we want to be as helpful as possible in educating our citizens. This is why we are conducting three of the seminars prior to the U.S. Congressional District 1 Primaries on Tuesday, March 19," said Joseph Debney, Executive Director of the Charleston County Board of Elections and Voter Registration office.
