## Charleston County Hosts Public Meeting for Palmetto Commerce Parkway: Phase III Project

*Discussions regarding proposed infrastructure project to be held at R.B. Stall High School on Sept. 10*

[Charleston County Government](#) will host a public introduction meeting to discuss the proposed Palmetto Commerce Parkway: Phase III (PCP3) infrastructure project. The meeting is scheduled for 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., Wednesday, Sept. 10, at [R.B. Stall High School, 3625 Ashley Phosphate Road](#), North Charleston. The introduction meeting will be conducted in an open-house format, with a project overview presentation at 6:30 p.m.

The [PCP3 project](#) is being designed to extend Palmetto Commerce Parkway from Ashley Phosphate Road to the current four-lane section of South Aviation Avenue near International Boulevard. This improvement is designed to provide relief from traffic congestion and an increase in infrastructure lifespan.

Meetings with key stakeholders and the community will be crucial throughout the ongoing planning, design, and permitting phases of the project. Project staff will present alternatives that are being studied and share findings on potential impacts for the community and residents. Attendees will have the opportunity to review exhibits, provide written comments, and meet one-on-one with Charleston County and project team representatives.

Note that the Sept. 10 meeting will not be a forum for spoken public comment. However, such a meeting will take place at a later date and will be announced/advertised in advance.

Throughout the planning process, there will be regular opportunities for community feedback via public meetings and the PCP3 project website at [pcp3.charlestoncounty.org](http://pcp3.charlestoncounty.org). Timelines with project status, significant milestones, and future public meetings will also be available on the website.
