New Greenbelt Projects Set for Review by Charleston County Greenbelt Advisory Board Subcommittee

The Charleston County Greenbelt Program has received applications for sixteen new projects totaling \$23.5 million to protect 3,289 acres across the county. A six-member subcommittee of the Charleston County Greenbelt Advisory Board (GAB) is scheduled to meet during the month of April to review the new applications. All meetings are open to the public, and will be held at the Lonnie Hamilton III Public Services Building, 4045 Bridge View Drive, North Charleston.

The subcommittee is appointed by the GAB to review, evaluate, and make recommendations to the GAB regarding applications for funding.

On April 10, the subcommittee will review the six Urban Projects received, consisting of 637 acres and totaling \$13 million.

Subcommittee meetings to review the ten Rural Projects, consisting of 2,652 acres and totaling \$10.5 million are scheduled for:

- Wednesday, April 17 at 9:00 a.m.
- Wednesday, April 24 at 9:00 a.m.

Funding for the Greenbelt Programs is through the Charleston County Transportation Sales Tax.
