June Primaries

Register to vote, check your polling location and absentee voting information

The Charleston County Board of Elections and Voter Registration is encouraging Charleston County residents to be ready to vote by checking their polling location for the June Primary Election on Tuesday, June 14. The new redistricting maps impacted some residents' districts and polling locations. The Board of Elections mailed out postcards that should arrive this week with details on the new voting districts and polling locations.

"There were a lot of changes with redistricting, and it is critical that registered voters check their new district information," said Board of Elections and Voter Registration Director Isaac Cramer. Citizens can also check this information and view a sample ballot on scvotes.gov.

Important dates regarding the June 14 Primary:

- May 13: Deadline to register to vote in-person.
- May 15: Deadline to register to vote online.
- May 16: Deadline to postmark mail-in voter registration.
- May 16: In-person absentee voting begins.

Citizens who qualify for absentee voting can vote from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Board of Elections Headquarters located at 4367 Headquarters Rd., North Charleston, SC 29405 from May 16 until June 13. Charleston County's Satellite Voting Unit (SVU) will also be available for absentee voting for those who qualify at the following locations from 9 a.m. - 2 p.m.

- June 1- Otranto Library: 2261 Otranto Rd., North Charleston, SC 29406
- June 3 Wando Library: 1400 Carolina Park Blvd., Mt. Pleasant, SC 29466
- June 6 James Island Baxter Patrick Library: 1858 S. Grimball Rd., Charleston, SC 29412
- June 8 John's Island Library: 3531 Maybank Hwy., Johns Island, SC 29455
- June 10 St. Paul's Hollywood Library: 5130 SC-165, Hollywood, SC 29449

Eligible voters do not need to register for a party to vote in a primary but can only vote in one primary or the other, and not both.
