

CHARLESTON COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2068

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018-2019 BUDGET ORDINANCE NO. 2019, TO PROVIDE FOR THE INCREASE OF ST. JOHN'S FIRE DISTRICT'S OPERATING BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING AN ADDITIONAL \$250,870 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2018, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2019, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS FISCAL YEAR 2019; TO PROVIDE FOR BUDGETARY CONTROL OF SAID APPROPRIATIONS BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL AND THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO.

WHEREAS, Charleston County Council enacted Ordinance Number 2019 on June 19, 2018, which provided approval of the Fiscal Year 2019 budget for the St. John's Fire District and

WHEREAS, the Commission has requested a revision to the budget ordinance, and

WHEREAS, as provided in Ordinance Number 2019, County Council must approve an amendment to said Budget Ordinance when fund totals are adjusted,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY CHARLESTON COUNTY COUNCIL that Charleston County Ordinance No. 2019 is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1:

Section 2 is amended by increasing the budget amount by \$250,870 so that Section 2 shall read as follows:

"That the General Fund Budget of the St. John's Fire District in the amount of \$13,012,637 is hereby approved by Charleston County Council."

SECTION 2: Section 4 is amended by increasing the budget amount of \$12,761,767 by \$250,870 so that Section 5 shall read as follows:

"The \$706,113 difference between the \$13,012,637 in budgeted disbursements and the \$12,306,524 in budgeted ad valorem taxes consists of other available funding sources."

SECTION 3: If any provision of this Ordinance or its applications to any circumstance is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid for any reason, this holding shall not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are declared by Council to be severable.

SECTION 4: The remainder of the original Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect following approval of third reading.

First Reading: June 4, 2019

Second Reading: June 25, 2019

Third Reading: July 30, 2019
